The Robbins Family consists of six weights ranging from light to black with corresponding italics. The basic skeleton for the design is a simple geometric sans but deviates in some subtle, and sometimes not so subtle ways.

Sharp corners are softly rounded and vertical stokes are drawn with a gentle flowing wave. This undulation gives an impression that there might be a slight spur serif on the upper left and lower right of each stroke.

The lower case forms have wide open counters and are bouncier than their geometric cousins as the elastic wave treatment continues throughout.

In text settings, Robbins is clean and direct with an underlying breezy cheerfulness. Playful idiosyncrasies start to appear in larger display settings.

ROBBINS UNYUCKY CREAMED CARROTS

10 Small Potatoes • 3 Tbsp Butter • 3 Tbsp Flour • 11/2 Cup Whole Milk • 1/4 Cup Parsley • 1/4 Cup Green Onion • **1/4 tsp** Salt • 1/4 tsp Pepper •

INGREDIENTS • Cut up the carrots into one inch **5** Large Carrots • chunks. If any of the small potatoes are large-ish, cut them in half. Start the carrots and potatoes boiling. They will be done about the same time that the sauce is ready.

> For the sauce: melt the butter on medium high in a medium sauce pan. Dump in the flour and stir for three or four minutes. Slowly whisk in the milk and stir until it is all

smooth. Let this simmer for ten minutes. While you are waiting around, chop up the parsley and onion. Then mix these into the sauce with the salt and pepper and let it all simmer for another five minutes, stirring occasionally.

By now the carrots and potatoes should be done. Drain and mix them with the sauce. If it all seems a little too thick, stir in some chicken broth. And it can't hurt to sprinkle on a bit of parmesan cheese if you happen have it laying around!



Growing up, there was nothing I despised more on the dinner table than creamed carrots. I liked cream and had nothing against carrots but the combination of the two was flat out hideous to my young palate. When my wife announced one night that we were having creamed carrots with the pork chops, I tried to talk her into making butternut squash instead. She knows I don't like butternut squash. She said not to worry, that I would like her Mom's version and it turned out she was right. Again. We have it quite often now and I have never once tried to sneak it under the table and into my socks like I always did as a kid.
